Applications for “Allied Laboratory” membership in AOSA must be received by the Membership Committee *on or before April 30th of the year application is made* prior to the annual meeting of the Association. ALLIED LABORATORIES – laboratories of government agencies and government institutions, outside the United States and Canada and as defined in Article IV Section 2, engaged in seed research, testing, training, and/or regulatory work shall be eligible for Allied laboratory status. Persons employed in technical and/or professional positions in Allied laboratories shall automatically become Allied Members. Allied members shall be eligible for appointment to but not serve as chairperson for any committees except subcommittees. They shall not be eligible for election as an officer or member of the Executive Board of the Association or entitled to vote in Association elections or other business of the Association.
