

HONORARY MEMBER NOMINATIONS

Definition: Honorary Members – Any person who has rendered signal service in one or more of the fields of activity of the Association mentioned in Article III (of the Bylaws) are eligible for Honorary Membership.

Criteria For Honorary Members as stated in the Bylaws - Article III:
OBJECT

The object of this Association shall be to improve seed testing in all its branches and to make it more useful to agriculture and society. The object shall be obtained through cooperative effort by:

1. Promoting uniform laboratory methods and practices through seed research.
2. Conducting referee tests among seed analysts of the Association for the purpose of developing uniform techniques.
3. Furthering the exchange of ideas among laboratories and among individual workers.
4. Fostering effective workable seed control legislation and regulation.
5. Improve seed testing in all its branches, to make it more useful to agriculture and society and any other lawful purposes.

Any Member of the Association may nominate a person for Honorary Membership. Such nominations shall be submitted to the Membership Committee on or before April 30th. If approved by the Executive Board, the name will be presented to the delegates at the Annual Meeting.
